

POSITIVE EVOLUTION

Our purpose is to support positive evolution for the planetary collective.

 - To seek and find direct realization of the mystical truth of Oneness. (The Truth)

OUR PHILOSOPHY: COSMIC ONENESS

We honor the timeless wisdom of a diversity of teachings, traditions, and cosmologies. We understand that there is a universal truth at the center of all positive expressions of spirituality.

We recognize this as the Perennial Philosophy, the Way of Cosmic Unity, or the Law of One.

OUR COMMUNITY: PRACTICING SACRED EMBODIMENT TOGETHER

We acknowledge that we are participating in an evolving creation. We play our part by gathering in circles to share best practices for living an evolutionary life, in alignment with Oneness. We choose to apply the insights gained through our paths by putting theory and idea into practice.

We gather regularly in various capacities to seek direct mystical realization of the Oneness of all things. We offer diverse opportunities for spiritual study and embodied practice.

OUR CULTURE: I IVING THE WAY OF THE OPEN HEART

We join the mystical traditions that proclaim the goodness of the universe and love at the center of all things. We align our thoughts, words, and deeds with that quality of kindness in order to co-create a supportive environment of freedom and aliveness to learn, heal, grow, and thrive together.

We aim to live with our hearts open, and to serve those around us.

CONTEXT

HISTORY

We began our collective journey in Asheville, North Carolina in June 2016 as a weekly study group of spiritual philosophy on the evolution of humankind. Since fall of 2019, devotion to a path of service has inspired several interwoven projects under the umbrella of our nonprofit church organization.

COMMUNITY

In the course of our collective seeking of truth and study of Oneness, we have cultivated a network of friends and relationships that comprise a rich and diverse community. The core of this community is made up of Asheville area locals. And through both our virtual and in-person meetings and events, and online platforms, we have also built meaningful connection with folks from all over the world. Our gatherings and events have touched the lives of hundreds of people.

SACRED PLACE

We're situated in a riparian forested wetland zone on the Swannanoa River in Western North Carolina, nestled in the Katúah bioregion of the Blue Ridge Mountains of Southern Appalachia.

This is where we will build the Temple of the Open Heart, a beautiful, majestic, inspiring spiritual gathering place. Creating this sacred space is one of the primary aims of the TOTOH project.

TOTOH holds a lease to 3 acres and two homes, which make up our current facilities. We are seeking to acquire stewardship rights for an additional 6 adjacent acres, which would allow us to expand our capacity.

PROJECTS

Our projects are **long-term undertakings** with no fixed beginning or end time; ongoing experiments in living the shift. Our current projects are:

RIVERLIGHT VILLAGE

Our village is a coalescing of kinship around harmonious ways of being with and uplifting one another; allowing that harmony to support our individual and interwoven paths of living into our essence and service.

The residents of the village share communal evening meals most nights of the week. We come together in twice-monthly meeting rhythms with intentions for keeping our collaborations flowing and emotions connected. And we share labor in improving our collectively stewarded land with monthly work parties.

STARSEEDS HOMESCHOOL COLLECTIVE

Our collective creates educational enrichment for homeschooling families on a shared spiritual path, and supports children to embody their gifts. Positive, spiritually-based education is foundational to humanity traversing the shift of ages.

We honor children's innate goodness, actively practicing cooperation and being of service through sharing authentic gifts. We believe that giving children healthy experiences of doing important and productive work in a community environment supports their full embodiment on Earth and their feeling of being a meaningful part of their world.

COMMUNITY POTLUCK & FIRE CIRCLE

This regular gathering (weekly or monthly, weather-dependent) is a space to be with the elements of our natural world, and to gather in sacred community. The intention of our fire circle and potluck is to connect, share, and witness each other in the challenges and celebrations of our spiritual journeys. The format is open and flexible and builds relationships based in understanding and trust.

Projects on hold. The following projects are currently on hold while we focus our efforts on organizational and team development, and fundraising:

ASHEVILLE LAW OF ONE STUDY GROUP

From June of 2016 through January of 2022, this community of independent seekers gathered weekly to study the spiritual philosophy of the Law of One.

The rhythm of this group was to gather, meditate, read and study, share perspectives on dimensional shift, unity consciousness, and other topics relevant to seekers. The aim was to balance and harmonize our own vessels, seeking the direct experience of Oneness that mystics have foretold through the ages.

We held regular in-person meetings to both study and practice the teachings of specific channeled material on the spiritual evolution of humankind. Study Group has been our flagship event, and the seed of so much else that TOTOH has become.

HARMONY COUNCIL

From February of 2020 through fall of 2021 Harmony Council hosted regular group events to practice cultivating harmony, and coordinated mediation for conflict resolution between individuals and within groups. Members of the Council were available to hear challenges of community members, and guide towards the appropriate strategies for resolution.

The Council articulated a set of agreements that create a cultural framework that optimize for individual self-awareness and self-responsibility and maximize successful transformation of conflict.



OFFERINGS

Our offerings are time-bound, specific containers for gathering in specific ways.

COMING HOME TO A NEW EARTH

In collaboration with our friends at L/L Research, Coming Home is an annual gathering of seekers from far and wide whose aim is to collectively empower the shift to 4th density positive. We come together for three days, with a circle of up to 55 people.

The gathering is held in Open Space format, with much of the content co-created by the participants through sharing practices, discussions, and connections for the development of mind, body, and spirit. Earth is transitioning. Our society is transitioning. And many recognize they are here on Earth for the purpose of assisting this transition. Through this gathering we hope to help further awaken and quietly strengthen this incarnational service within ourselves.

ABIDING IN THE HEART

A year-long collective journey into meditative self-inquiry.

Abiding in the Heart is an online program built to support a group through a year of consistent meditation practice; to shift their relationship to their mind and thinking, and thus to their world.

CEREMONIAL INQUIRY

Ceremonial Inquiry is part satsang, part practice group. It's an invitation into a non-ordinary, sacred container for discovery of our true nature. With guided meditation, we each travel on our parallel inner journey, and come together in the end to share insights, takeaways, and impact with one another. The intention for this experimental container is about blending the boundary of inner and outer transformation.

APPEAL

We are seeking support to develop our capacities to serve, and succeed in our mission.

We believe that serving each other in healing and spiritual awakening is essential. All the more so in these times of social divisiveness, and individual and collective suffering. We are taking a bold stand for individual and collective transformation that serves the positive evolution of Earth.

We are seeking to raise \$4,000,000 to fund sustained operation and development of the organization, land acquisition, site construction, and building the temple, the school, staff, student and guest housing and supporting facilities. We anticipate this will be done in three phases over the next 5 - 10 years:

Phase 1: Heart of the Mission

\$2.2M: Land acquisition, site preparation, and construction of the temple.

Phase 2: Sustainable Operations

\$1.8M: Endowment to support on-going salaries for core team to move into full-time growth & development of the organization. (\$1.8M @ 5% yearly return = \$90K, or \$30K/yr each for 3 directors.)






